During this lesson, Ms. Sandra placed special emphasis on helping students confidently introduce themselves, say their age, and formally introduce themselves to our new classmate.

We also practiced colors through interactive games, reinforcing vocabulary in a more dynamic way. Additionally, students practiced numbers up to 20, focusing on fluency and quick recall.

What We Practiced This Week

Greetings & Introductions

Students practiced introducing themselves using complete sentences:

- Hola. – Hello.
- ¿Cómo te llamas? – What is your name?
- Me llamo _____. – My name is _____.
- ¿Cuántos años tienes? – How old are you?
- Tengo ____ años. – I am ____ years old.
- Mucho gusto. – Nice to meet you.
- Encantado / Encantada. – Nice to meet you (male/female speaker).

Students practiced asking and answering these questions while introducing themselves to a new student.



Numbers

We reviewed and extended numbers:

- **Uno, dos, tres, cuatro, cinco... veinte.** – One, two, three, four, five... twenty.

Students counted objects, participated in oral counting games, and practiced responding quickly when prompted.

Colors (Through Games)

We practiced recognizing and using:

- **Rojo** – Red
- **Azul** – Blue
- **Verde** – Green
- **Amarillo** – Yellow

Students used these colors in interactive classroom games rather than simple repetition drills.





Days of the Week

Students reviewed:

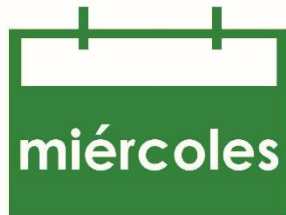
- **Lunes** – Monday
- **Martes** – Tuesday
- **Miércoles** – Wednesday
- **Jueves** – Thursday
- **Viernes** – Friday
- **Sábado** – Saturday
- **Domingo** – Sunday

We practiced asking:

- **¿Qué día es hoy?** – What day is it today?
- **Hoy es ____.** – Today is ____.

Color Challenge

Ask your child:

- **Dime tres cosas que son rojas.** – Tell me three things that are red.
- **Busca algo azul.** – Find something blue.

At-Home Practice Tips

Short, consistent practice (5–10 minutes) makes a big difference.

1. Introduction Practice

Have your child introduce themselves:

- **Hola, me llamo ___. Tengo ___ años.**
Hello, my name is ___. I am ___ years old.

Encourage clear pronunciation and complete sentences.

2. Counting Practice

Count objects around the house:

- **Vamos a contar hasta veinte.** – Let's count to twenty.
- **Cuenta conmigo.** – Count with me.

Try counting forward and backward.



3. Color Game

Say a color in Spanish and have your child find an object that matches:

- **Busca algo verde.** – Find something green.
- **Encuentra algo amarillo.** – Find something yellow.

4. Daily Calendar Question

Ask daily:

- **¿Qué día es hoy?** – What day is it today?
- **Hoy es ____.** – Today is ____.

This builds automatic recall.
